ORDINANCE NO. 1154

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16-48 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA RELATING
TO DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS.**

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

Section 1. Section 16-48 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miles City, Montana is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 16-48. Fireworks.

“It shall be unlawful for any person to discharge or cause to be discharged any fireworks, as defined by state law, within the city limits; provided that the city council may grant a permit for a supervised public display of fireworks to be held by the city, fair association, amusement park or other organizations or groups of individuals. The City Council, by resolution, may allow the discharge of fireworks at special times and places as deemed appropriate as long as such use is in accordance with state law and any other reasonable restrictions which the Council may impose in order to preserve the public peace and safety.”


Section 2. This amendment shall become effective thirty (30) days following its final passage.

Said ordinance read and put on its passage this 12th day of April, 2005.






