ORDINANCE NO. 1216

AN ORDINANCE REVISING SECTION 2-107 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA REGARDING EMPLOYMENT, SUPERVISION, SUSPENSION AND DISCHARGE OF EMPLOYEES SO AS TO CONFORM TO STATE STATUTE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-107 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miles City, Montana is amended to read as follows:

“Sec. 2-107. Authority to employ, supervise, suspend, and discharge employees and non-elected officers.

(1) Department heads and employees: The mayor may appoint, with the consent of a majority of the council, all department heads, and remove department heads and may appoint and remove all other department employees..

(2) Non-elected officers: The mayor has power to

(a) nominate and, with the consent of the council, appoint all nonelective officers of the city provided for by the council, except as provided by state law;

(b) suspend and, with the consent of the council, remove any nonelective officer, stating in the suspension or removal the cause for the removal;

(c) supervise the discharge of official duty by all subordinate officers;

(d) require of any of the officers of a city or town an exhibit of the officer's books and papers;

(3) Removal of non-elected officer: The council, upon written charges to be entered upon their journal, after notice to the party, and after trial by the council, may remove any nonelected officer by vote of two-thirds of all the members-elect.


(4) Supervision of departments and boards: The mayor may exercise control and supervision of all departments and boards to the degree authorized by ordinance of the council.

(5) Compensation: The city council shall have the right to fix the compensation and prescribe the duties of all employees and elected and non-elected officers of the city.

(6) This section shall not apply to the employment of members of the police force, fire department, and any other city employee for whose employment a different method may be prescribed by the laws of the state.”

Section 2. This amendment shall become effective thirty (30) days after the final passage of this Ordinance.

Said ordinance read and put on its passage this 8th day of March, 2011.


