RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE MULTI-JURISDICTIONAL APPLICATION

WHEREAS, Custer County is applying to the Montana Department of Commerce for a Community Development Block Grant – Economic Development Program grant for a multi-jurisdictional grant to enable Miles Community College to purchase and renovate the Miles City Armory for the purpose of using the facility for its Commercial Vehicle and Heavy Equipment Operator Training Programs;


WHEREAS, the City of Miles City, as one of the participating jurisdictions, has authorized Custer County to apply for the grant on its behalf;
