ORDINANCE NO. 1146

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-53 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA RELATING TO TIME OF CITY COUNCIL MEETINGS.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

Section 1. Section2-53 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miles City, Montana is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-53. Presiding officer; roll call; quorum.

The City Council shall convene and be called to order by the Mayor, or in the absence of the Mayor, by the president of the Council, and in the absence of both the Mayor and the President of the Council, by the City Clerk, at 7:00 p.m. on the days designated for each meeting, unless otherwise ordered. The Clerk shall proceed to call the roll and record in the minutes the names of all members present and announce whether or not a quorum is present. In case of the temporary absence of the Mayor and the president of the Council, if a quorum of aldermen is present, they shall choose one of their number to act as presiding officer at the meeting and proceed with the business.

Section 2. This amendment shall become effective thirty (30) days following its final passage.
