ORDINANCE NO. 1199

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 22-2, 22-183, 22-194 AND 22-212 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY REGARDING DEFINITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES, PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES AND PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-183 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Miles City, Montana is amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 22-2. Definitions

1) Webicle

a. Authorized emergency vehicles means vehicles of the fire department, fire patrol, police vehicles or such ambulances and emergency vehicles as are designated or authorized by an appropriate state agency.
b. Bicycle means every device propelled by human power which any person may ride, having two tandem wheels either of which is more than 20 inches in diameter.

c. Bus means every motor vehicle designed for carrying more than ten passengers and used for the transportation of persons; and every motor vehicle, other than a taxicab, designed and used for the transportation of persons for compensation.

d Camper means a structure designed to be mounted in the cargo area of a truck or attached to an incomplete vehicle for the purpose of providing shelter for persons. The term includes but is not limited to a cab-over, half cab-over, noncab-over, telescopic, and telescopic cab-over.

 Commercial motor vehicle means a motor vehicle or combination of motor vehicles used in commerce to transport passengers or property if the vehicle:

> (i) has a gross combination weight rating or a gross combination weight of 26,001 pounds or more, whichever is greater, inclusive of a towed unit with a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000 pounds;

(ii) has a gross vehicle weight rating or a gross vehicle weight of 26,001 pounds or more, whichever is greater;

(iii) is designed to transport at least 16 passengers, including the driver;

(iv) is a school bus; or

(v) is of any size and is used in the transportation of hazardous materials as defined in 61-8-801.

f. Emergency service vehicles means emergency service vehicles of state, county or municipal departments or public service vehicles which, by the nature of their operation, cause a vehicular traffic hazard; or authorized tow cars.

g. Motorcycle means every motor vehicle having a seat or saddle for the use of the rider and designed to travel on not more than three wheels in contact with the ground, but excluding a tractor.

h. Motor-driven cycle means every motorcycle, including every motor scooter, with a motor which produces not greater than five horsepower, and every bicycle with a motor attached.
