RESOLUTION NO. 3511

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO §16-48 OF THE MILES CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES, ESTABLISHING DATES, TIMES AND LOCATIONS FOR DISCHARGE OF FIREWORKS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS AND PERMITTING A PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY BY THE VETERANS OF FOREIGN WARS POST 1579.

WHEREAS, §16-48 of the Miles City Code of Ordinances permits the City Council to establish special times and places at which fireworks may be discharged within the city limits of the City of Miles City and to permit a supervised public display of fireworks to be held by the an organization;

AND WHEREAS, the City Council desires to establish certain locations and certain times and dates at which fireworks may be discharged within the city limits during the 4th of July holiday period;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

- All fireworks so discharged shall comply with all State of Montana and federal regulations.
- 2. The Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW) Post 1579 is permitted to conduct a supervised public display of fireworks on the evening of July 4th of each year at the Miles City Swim Pool in the Denton Sports Complex.
- 3. The discharge of fireworks within the city limits, or upon any property of the City of Miles City, on any other dates, at any other times, or at any other locations is prohibited and such prohibition shall be enforced by the Miles City Police Department.
- 4. This Resolution shall remain in effect until repealed, modified or replaced by further resolution of the City Council.

SAID RESOLUTION FINALLY PASSED AND ADOPTED BY A DULY CONSTITUTED QUORUM OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY, MONTANA, AT A DULY NOTICED SPECIAL MEETING THIS 2ND DAY OF JULY, 2012.
