RESOLUTION NO. 3536

A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING A LOADING ZONE ON THE NORTH WEST CORNER OF WASHINGTON STREET AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH EIGHTH STREET, AND GRANTING A PERMIT THEREFOR TO ED MARTIN, AND AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF LOADING ZONE SIGNS AT SUCH LOCATION.

WHEREAS Sec. 22-186 of the Miles City Code of Ordinances permits the establishment of loading zones and the granting of permits therefor;

AND WHEREAS, Edward Martin has made application for the establishment of a loading zone on the northwest corner of Washington Street at its intersection with Eighth Street;

AND WHEREAS, the Mayor, with the concurrence of the City Council, has determined that such location is an appropriate place to designate as a loading zone during such hours;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana as follows:

- 1. It hereby approves the establishment of a loading zone on the northwest corner of Washington Street at its intersection with Eighth Street and the issuance of a permit therefor to Ed Martin, the permittee, for one passenger vehicle at such location to be utilized 24 hours per day;
- 2. Ed Martin shall pay the annual service and maintenance fee for the loading permit as provided for by Sec. 22-186(b), and upon such payment, the City Clerk shall issue the permit;
- 3. The permit shall be good until December 31, 2012 and may be reissued annually thereafter upon payment of the permit fee, unless otherwise revoked by the City Council;
- 4. The permittee shall purchase, maintain and keep in place two signs to indicate the ends of the zone, the signs to be purchased from the City, and no other type of signs shall be posted in the zone granted to the permittee;
- 5. The City Council reserves the right to cancel or suspend such permit at any time;
