## **RESOLUTION NO. 3823**

A RESOLUTION LEVYING AND ASSESSING A TAX UPON ALL PROPERTY IN SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT LIGHTING DISTRICT NO. 165 TO DEFRAY THE COST OF LEASING, MAINTENANCE AND ELECTRICAL CURRENT IN SAID SPECIAL IMPROVEMENT LIGHTING DISTRICT AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING PAYMENT THEREFORE, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Miles City, Montana did, on the 25th of February, 1968, create a special improvement district in said City, known and designated as Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165; and,

**WHEREAS**, the whole cost of LEASING, MAINTENANCE AND ELECTRICAL CURRENT for the fiscal year of 2015-2016 is estimated by the City Council at the sum of \$168,594 and,

WHEREAS, the property in said Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165 is to be assessed one hundred percent (100%) of the cost during the fiscal year 2015-2016 for LEASING, MAINTENANCE AND ELECTRICAL CURRENT for each lot or parcel of land within Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165.

## NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF MILES CITY, MONTANA, THAT:

Section 1: To defray one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of LEASING, MAINTENANCE AND ELECTRICAL CURRENT in Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165, there shall be levied and assessed a tax upon all property in Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165 amounting to 0.005611 per square foot;

- Section 2: A description of each lot or parcel of land, the total square footage of property contained therein, the name of the owner and the amount assessed against each lot or parcel of land in Special Improvement Lighting District 165, is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, and shall, upon passage, be kept on file in the City Clerk's Office.
- Section 3: The City Council of Miles City, Montana, will be in session at the City Council Chambers on the 25th day of August, 2015, at 7:00 P.M., at which time and place the said Council will hear objections to the final adoption of this resolution.
- Section 4: The City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to publish in a newspaper of general circulation within the City of Miles City, in the manner provided for in 7-1-4127 MCA, a

notice stating that the resolution levying the special assessment to defray the cost of LEASING, MAINTENANCE AND ELECTRICAL CURRENT for Special Improvement Lighting District No. 165 is on file at City Hall and subject to inspection.

Section 5: Said notice shall state time and place at which objections to the final adoption of this resolution will be heard by the City Council, and the last publication of said notice shall be published at least five (5) days before the time set by the Council for hearing objections to the final adoption of this resolution.


