Chairperson Berg stated Holy Rosary Hospital has scheduled Hazemat Awareness for September 20th and Exxon Mobile is trying to host a regional "Oil Spill Response" for sometime in September or October.

Director Kelm suggested the Committee obtain up-to-date training videos from MMIA or MACO. HR Officer Burkhalter stated she will work on this.

Chairperson Berg will continue to try to get in touch with the Department of Labor to get the information concerning required training for each department.
