## **RESOLUTION NO. 4135**

A RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO §7-6-4006 OF THE MONTANA CODE ANNOTATED, AUTHORIZING AWARD OF AN URBAN RENEWAL AGENCY DIRECT GRANT FOR INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, AND AMENDMENT OF FINAL BUDGET FOR FY 2017-2018 TO INCREASE THE BUDGETED AMOUNT IN FUND 2510-107-430235-230.

WHEREAS, Public Works Department on behalf of Special Improvement District No. 2510 has applied for an Urban Renewal Agency Direct Grant for Infrastructure Improvements, has met all the program criteria to receive said grant, and the Miles City Urban Renewal Board of Commissioners has recommended that the City Council award a grant in the amount of \$5,000 to the City's Public Works Department to be used toward the construction of curb and gutter and alley repairs within the Urban Renewal District of Miles City Montana;

The appropriations for the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 for Special Improvement District No. 2510 / SID 204 Fund No. 2510-107-430235-230 shall be increased in the following amount: \$5,000.00.

The following budget transfer is hereby authorized:

Transfer \$5,000 from TIFD/Down Town Fund No. 2310-011-521000-820 to Special Improvement District No. 2510 / SID 204 Fund No. 2510-383000

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a public hearing shall be held on the above proposed amendment to the Final Budget for Fiscal Year 2017-2018 on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March, 2018, at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers at City Hall, Miles City, Montana. The City Clerk shall cause notice of such hearing to be published in the Miles City Star, in accordance with §7-1-4128 MCA, at least 2 times with at least 6 days separating each publication.
