APPROVAL OF PRIOR MEETING MINUTES

• Pat Lifto made a motion to approve the February 12, 2018 Minutes. Ken Gartner seconded the motion. Motion passed.

OLD BUSINESS

KLI Update -Craig Canfield.

- Coalboard Grant awarded June 2017 will pay the matching for the Design for the 2020 Project and the contract should be coming soon. Craig Canfield asked if he or Lorrie (City) would be managing the Grant. Jeff Langkau will discuss with Lorrie and Doug Phair before making the decision.
- Craig Canfield will be working on the Digressionary Funds with possible 2 smaller grants.
- Craig went over the Project Work for 2018-2019,
 - Agis Survey for RW 4-33 Threshold Relocation.
 - O Design for Runway 4-22 Threshold Relocation. The runway will be shortened on one end and extended on the other to cover the Protection Zone.
 - o Design for runway intersection reconfiguration including replace Taxi Way.
 - o Design for Helipad Relocation.
 - o Replace Airport Beacon changing electrical work.
 - o Taxilane and County T-Hanger Apron Reconstruction.
 - o Pavernent Maintenance (Taxiways A, B, C, and Apron.
 - o Acquire SRE (Tool Cat Blade, Broom, and Blower). Jeff Langkau presented equipment he had researched, and Craig explained the process of getting the equipment.
 - Taxiways not included in this project.
 - o Morris and Maierle will be working on estimate for the 2020 Project and Snow Equipment.
- The process to get another Coalboard Grant should begin to help with the matching funds for the 2020 Project. Craig felt some funds may be available from the Montana Aeronautics (possible \$100,000) which application would be in 2019.
