ORDINANCE NO. 1368

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 2-86 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF MILES CITY REGARDING ELECTIVE AND
APPOINTIVE OFFICERS.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Miles City, Montana, as follows:

Section 1. Section 2-86 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2-86. - Designation of elective and appointive officers.

The officers of the city shall consist of elective officers and appointive officers. The elective officers shall be one mayor, one treasurer, one city judge and two aldermen from each ward as provided by law. The appointive officers shall be one city attorney, one city clerk, one chief of police, one chief of the fire department, a city engineer, a one city building inspector, one dispatch supervisor, one public works director, one public utilities director, one police commission consisting of three members, and such other officers and boards as the council may from time to time create or authorize by ordinance or resolution and in accordance with state law.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after its final passage.
